Subject: Permission for admission in Sri Basaveshwar Rural Education and Development Trust's Sri Sathya Sai College of Homoeopathic Medical Sciences, Plot No. 19 'C', Industrial Area, Sattur, Dharwad-580009, Karnataka with 50 seats in UG (BHMS) course for the academic session 2020-21-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder and Ministry's policy for the academic year 2020-21, In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has examined the Part-1 of the proforma of inspection of college submitted by the Sri Sathya Sai College of Homoeopathic Medical Sciences and furnished the recommendation as under:

"Recommended for allowing admission in I-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 with the intake capacity of 50 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course.

The Committee also recommended to apprise the Ministry that website of college is not updated, and 02 out of 31 teachers are ineligible. Details of ineligible teachers are as under:

3. *Dr N S Dodamani (Prof. Physiology) – Not considered eligible as not having required teaching experience in Physiology, as having experience in Anatomy during 01-02-2012 to 31-01-2016 as Lecturer, from 01-02-2016 to 30-6-2017 as Associate Prof. and joined Physiology in 01-7-2017 to 3-02-2019 as Asso. Prof. and from 04-02-2019 to till date as Professor in Physiology.*

4. *Dr Sharan Reddy (Lecurer, FMT) – Not considered eligible as age exceeded 40 years (DOB- 03-06-1976) at the time of joining (DOJ – 1-4-2019) as Lecturer. MD done in 2008."*

2. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, observation of hearing committee and recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, **conditional permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Sri Basaveshwar Rural Education and Development Trust's Sri Sathya Sai College of Homoeopathic Medical Sciences, Plot No. 19 'C', Industrial Area, Sattur, Dharwad-580009, Karnataka for continuing admissions in 1-BHMS course during the academic year 2020-21 with intake capacity of 50 seats, subject to availability of updated website before 31st December, 2020.**

3. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counselling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government vide letter F. No. L. 11011/02/2020-E-(1) dated 26.10.2020 for A.Y. 2020-21 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counselling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.

5. The College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an affidavit duly notarized within one month from the date of issue of this letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

6. Further, the College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31st December, 2019 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2021-22.

7. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31st December, 2020 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2021-22 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.
