Sir,

Sri Basaveshwar Rural Education and Development Trust Sri Sathya Sai College of Homoeopathic Medical sciences functional since 2004 has applied for sanction of UG (BHMS) course with 50 seats for the academic year 2024-25. The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under clause 28 of NCH Act 2020.

On careful examination of the application, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has observed the following shortfalls as per MSR requirements:

Miscellaneous

- Adhaar enabled biometric attendance system (AEBAS)- No. The same may be implemented within 30 days.
- Compliance with circular issued on CCTV surveillance system – No data submitted.

Teaching staff

- Biometric attendance for the teaching and non-teaching staff not submitted. The same may be submitted for verification.
- Form 16 is not provided from the trace's portal. The copy of Form 16 from the traces portal may be submitted for verification.

OPD and IPD Department

Demographic details of patients are not recorded on case sheets. Diagnosis and proper case taking is not done with no follow-ups of the patients. Case records shall be maintained with detailed case history, complete case analysis, evaluation, repertorisation and justification of prescription made available in the medical record room for academic purposes of students and follow up attendance of patients.

Considering the above observations and facilities available, Medical Assessment and Rating Board has decided to issue **Conditional Permission to Sri Basaveshwar Rural Education and Development Trust Sri Sathya Sai College of Homoeopathic Medical sciences, Plot No. 19 'C' Industrial Area, Sattur, Dharwad-580009, Karnataka with admission intake capacity of 50 seats for undergraduate (BHMS) for the academic year 2024-25.**

All deficiencies noticed shall be rectified within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification.

All admissions shall be made for NEET qualified candidates only. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85 % seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT

The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

Permission to college will be withdrawn or denied in the subsequent year if college is found deficient in compliance to MSR 2013 anytime during the academic year.
