**Sub: Application for letter of permission for functioning of Sri Basaveshwar Rural Education and Development Trust Sri Sathya Sai College of Homoeopathic Medical Sciences, Plot No. 19 'C', Industrial Area, Sattur, Dharwad-580009 for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 50 seats for academic year 2025-26 – reg.**

Sir,

Sri Basaveshwar Rural Education and Development Trust Sri Sathya Sai College of Homoeopathic Medical Sciences, Plot No. 19 'C', Industrial Area, Sattur, Dharwad-580009, has applied for permission for sanction of 50 seats in BHMS course for the academic year 2025-26. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted Inspection on 27.06.2025 and 28.06.2025, followed by Virtual hearing on 16/07/2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 and 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls: -

**1. Deficiency of Teaching Faculty - (10 deficiencies as per credentials submitted by college)**

- 01 Assistant Professor in the Department of Human Physiology.  
**Dr. Namrataha H P**, who completed her MD in POM in 2022 and joined on Feb. 19, 2025, has **not cleared NTET**.
- 01 Assistant Professor and 01 Associate Professor in the Department of Anatomy.
- 01 Assistant Professor in the Department of Organon of medicine.
- 01 Professor in the Department of Pathology.
- 01 Associate Professor in the Department of Surgery.
- 01 Professor in the Department of Obstetrics & Gynecology.
- 01 Associate Professor in the Department of Repertory.
- 01 Assistant Professor in the Department of Community Medicine.  
**Dr. Vishakha D P**, who completed her MD in POM in 2022 and joined on Feb. 25, 2025, has **not cleared NTET**.
- 01 Assistant Professor in the Department of Pharmacy.  
**Dr. Deepa**, who completed her MD in POM in 2018 and joined on May. 05, 2025, has **not cleared NTET**.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of 10 teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40+1 for 50 seats BHMS(UG) college (As specified in MES,2024). Pursuant to F.No.: 3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dated 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college up to 50 seats can avail 15% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 15%, college still has deficiencies of 04 full time teaching faculty. However, such relaxed number of teachers may be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

**2. In Department of Human Physiology:**

- i. In biochemistry department, hot air oven, binocular research microscope, ophthalmoscope, otorhinolaryngoscope are not available.

**3. In Department of Homoeopathic Pharmacy:**

- i. All Pharmacopoeias are not available.
- ii. In list of equipment spectroscope, potentiometer, Electric triturator, glass retort, Bunsen burner, drugs samples prepared by students like Euphrasia, hydroskis, mullein oil; vehicles like glycerine, olive oil, lanolin, wax; glass phials; chopping board; chopping knife; burette; press; sieve; graduated conical glass; wire gauze are not available according to MES 2024.
- iii. All models are not available.

**4. In Department of Pathology:**

- i. In list of items like Glass dropper; Ziehl-Neelsen stain; Drabkin's solution; MacConkey's media; Lowenstein-Jensen media; rotary microtome; chemicals; cover glass slip; Elisa reader; urinometer are not available.

**5. In Department of Forensic Medicine:**

- i. In list of equipment like for measuring height and comparison microscope are not available.
- ii. In Museum, requirements like vertical section of tooth; hair root; cadaveric spasm; marbling sign; coup & countercoup injuries and intracranial hemorrhage are not available.

**6. In Department of Community Medicine:**

- i. Statistical Software is not available.
- ii. Statistical Assistant is not available.

**7. In Department of Obstetrics & Gynecology:**

- i. Specimens like chocolate cyst and abortus are not available.
- ii. Model like foetal skull which is not available in department.

**8. In Department of Practice of medicine:**

- i. In charts or digital display like GCS scale; respiratory, genitourinary system examination; clinical examination in blood disorder; normal hematological & biochemical values are not available.

**9. In department of Yoga for health promotion:**

- i. All items in yoga department are not available except patient record register and yoga mat.

**10. Hospital information:**

- i. Equipment for anesthesia, O.T., Labor room, central laboratories are not available.
- ii. In Rehabilitation unit, all instruments are not available.

**11. Hospital deficient staff Information:**

- i. Pathologist (fulltime) is not available.
- ii. Operation theatre nurse and assistant are not available as per schedule III.
- iii. Dietician (fulltime) is not available.

**12. Miscellaneous:**

- i. Pay scale of all the teaching and non-teaching staff are not according to MES- 2024.
- ii. Credentials like experience certificates, joining letter, NTET certificate of teaching are not available.
- iii. College has not applied for NABL Accreditation for clinical laboratory.
- iv. College has not applied for NABH.
- v. Clinical teaching rooms and skill lab are not available.
- vi. Emergency unit is not available.
- vii. College is not registered on AEBAS portal.

13. Considering the above observations during inspection and virtual hearing, MARBH has decided to issue **Permission to Sri Basaveshwar Rural Education and Development Trust Sri Sathya Sai College of Homoeopathic Medical Sciences, Plot No. 19 'C', Industrial Area, Sattur, Dharwad-580009 for continuing UG (BHMS) course with intake capacity of 35 seats (reduced from 50) for academic year 2025 – 26.**
14. All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of 35 seats for BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counselling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT designated by Central Government. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Govt. for All India Quota or the student admitted thereunder.
15. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
16. **If the College is aggrieved by any decision of the Autonomous Board, college may prefer an appeal to the Commission against such decision within 30 days of the communication of such decision as per National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions) Regulations 2024, section 14 subsection (1) and NCH General Regulation 2023 'section 22. The Manner of instructions for appeal are attached.**
